Results: Overall results will be generated as well as division specific results for J2 and older.

National Ranking List (NRL): Racers wishing to be scored on the NRL must hold a current USSA competition license prior to competing, and note the number on the entry form.

Intermountain Division JN Selection: Intermountain racers wishing to qualify for Junior Nationals must hold a current Intermountain competition license prior to competing in order to be scored. **Scoring only applies to J2 and older.**
